All proposals must be submitted to programme@ictd.org.uk by 11.59 pm GMT on 2nd April 2010

The Workshop/Panel/Session Committee will review the proposals against four criteria:

- excellence (quality of proposed content and organisation)
- justification of format (reasons why this format is appropriate)
- participation (evidence of interactivity and participatory approaches)
- diversity (evidence of inclusivity and diversity of participation)

Successful submissions will be announced by 11th June 2010.
